Mission Statement

The mission of Kids Repair Program is to provide positive experience and educational opportunities in bicycle safety, repair, maintenance and biking, as healthy exercise for youth in the Tri-County area.



Spring Fundraiser Bike Sale had several wonderful refurbished bikes. Kids Repair Program has two bike sales a year, one in the spring and one in the fall. Fall is currently open. In the spring it's meant to connect people with bikes they can ride in the good weather. In the fall, the bikes make wonderful affordable gifts to the little ones during the holidays. The bikes are refurbished by volunteer and our shop manager, Steve Readett and placed on the sales floor in the classroom area at KRP. Bikes are generally ½ price or less and ones either too small to use in our youth training program or too large to be used with the youth. Since all bikes coming to KRP are donated, some we can use in the program that youth will learn on and take home at completion, and some end up being refurbished if possible and sold to help with program expenses which then allows KRP to offer the program at a very reasonable cost. Bike Camp! Kids Repair Program every summer offers one week Bike Camp sessions. Once the youth, ages 10 to 17 completes the program they take home a new helmet, new lock, the bike they learned on and knowledge of the rules of the road, biking as healthy exercise, repairs and maintenance. Summers KRP hires a bike instructor and also provides a class monitor to aide in instructors.

Last Bike Camp session of summer 2019 was taught at a near by apartment complex on site in the clubhouse. 15 youth participated, 9 bikes were given to youth.

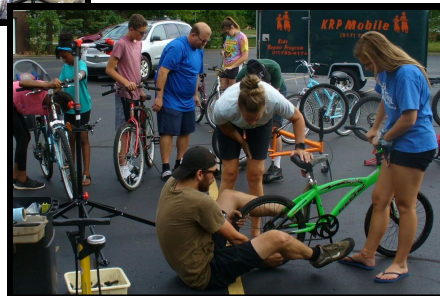
Harmony Celebration at Benjamin Davis Park, KRP did a bike rodeo and gave away 3 bikes in free drawings.

Summer Sessions! Only a \$20 deposit holds your slot in one of our 10 Bike Camp sessions. \$50 per each youth ages 10 to 17. Summer camper receives instruction in repairing, maintaining, healthy exercise and nutrition plus they take home the bike they learned on, helmet, and lock. Classes meet M to F, 9:00 AM to 1:30 PM. 7 students per class session.

Class monitors, age 18 and over assist the camp instructor. If you are interested in a week of monitoring, please call. \$100 per week stipend is paid. Hours same as camp hours. KRP offers AFTER SCHOOL classes during the school year! Call for information.
